The Canadian Institute of Nuclear Physics (CINP) is a national organization whose purpose is to fairly represent and effectively advocate the interests and goals of the Canadian Nuclear Physics research community to relevant agencies and parties. The CINP has individual faculty members from coast to coast, and is managed by a Board of Directors appointed by institutional members representing Canadian universities in 6 provinces and the TRIUMF research laboratory.

The CINP is looking for an Executive Director to oversee the day-to-day operations of the Institute, to represent it on various external advisory and review committees, to lead the planning and co-ordination of the nuclear physics community's long-term research priorities as reflected by its Scientific Working Groups, and to assist in the recruitment of new institutional, individual and associate members. Candidates must be a current or recently-retired faculty member who is eligible for CINP membership. The successful candidate will be a nationally recognized researcher in nuclear physics, and possesses excellent leadership and communication skills. The position is expected to be part-time, with remuneration provided for partial teaching relief (if applicable) or a stipend. Travel and other expenses will be fully reimbursed.
